Directions

From Exit 2 off I-91, take Route 9 West for 1.2 miles

Go left on Greenleaf Street just after the 7-11

Follow for 1.4 miles and go left on Hinesburg Road

Follow for 3.8 miles and go right on Colyer Road

Park as directed at the bottom of the hill and take the shuttle up to the farm
