UP ROUTE 30 TO THE NEWFANE FLEA MARKET,
LOVELY PAVED BROOKLINE LOOP, BACK TO START.

60 MILES (ALMOST A METRIC CENTURY!)

UP RTE 30 TO TOWNSHEND, RTE 35 TO GRAFTON, RTE 121 TO SAXTONS RIVER,
WESTMINSTER WEST ROAD TO PUTNEY, RTE 5 TO BRATTLEBORO, BACK TO START.

Group start times are 8:30 a.m. for 60 miles, 9 a.m. for 32 miles and 9:30 a.m. for 13 miles.

Map and cue sheets for each ride will be provided at check-in.

Sag stops will be located at the covered bridge, Brookline School, Grafton Ponds and the Putney Coop.
